We had robust conversations about rights of nature, rights of rivers and water bodies, Indigenous governance, tribal government-to-government consultation, opportunities to organize and build coalitions of Native American Tribes across the state around IRWM, tribal cultural, ceremonial, and subsistence needs related to the river and water stewardship. The majority of attendees were under 40 and represented a diverse cross section of local Indigenous (Chumash, Tongva, Acjachemen), and urban Indigenous (Osage, Navajo), community organizers, artists, scholars, and tribal council members. Local tribal community members and urban Indian community members all expressed interest in remaining involved in conversations about Indigenous water needs.
